*Quercus virginiana*

- Evergreen
- Average life: 200+ years
- Average mature height and width: 40'-60' x 60'-100'



Southern Magnolia  
*Magnolia grandiflora*

- Evergreen, white flowers
- Average life: 80-120 years
- Average mature height and width: 40'-60' x 20'-40'



Overcup Oak  
*Quercus lyrata*

- Deciduous, red fall color
- Average life: 150-200 years
- Average mature height and width: 50'-80' x 4'-50'
