

Rating Action: Moody's Ratings upgrades Woman's Hospital Foundation (LA) to A1; outlook stable

New York, December 17, 2025 -- Moody's Ratings (Moody's) has upgraded Woman's Hospital Foundation's (LA) (WHF) revenue bond rating to A1 from A2. The outlook was revised to stable from positive. WHF has approximately \$256 million of debt outstanding.

The upgrade to A1 is driven by WHF's strong operating performance, excellent liquidity, and improved leverage metrics.

RATINGS RATIONALE

The A1 rating reflects WHF's very good market position, financial performance above peers, and excellent liquidity. A dominant statewide position in women's and infant services is supported by its specialized focus and strong brand equity. WHF saw strong volume trends in 2025, defying national birth trends, while growing cancer services and new offerings in perinatal mental health and pediatric intensive care enhance clinical depth. Financial performance will remain robust, with an operating cash flow margin of about 13% in fiscal 2025 and liquidity at nearly 598 days cash on hand, aided by supplemental Medicaid funding. These strengths are tempered by modest scale (\$527 million operating revenue) and elevated leverage, though cash to debt of about 300% reflects significant balance sheet improvement. Other challenges include heavy Medicaid reliance, which exposes the organization to policy risk, and limited service diversification, constraining flexibility and growth opportunities

RATING OUTLOOK

The stable outlook reflects the likelihood that WHF will continue to generate very good operating performance and maintain its excellent liquidity.

FACTORS THAT COULD LEAD TO AN UPGRADE OF THE RATING

- Significant enterprise growth and increased draw for specialized services
- Material strengthening of leverage metrics

FACTORS THAT COULD LEAD TO A DOWNGRADE OF THE RATING

- Increase in debt or deterioration of leverage metrics such that cash to debt is sustained below 250% or debt to cash flow maintained above 3x
- Sustained period of materially lower operating cash flow margins
- Reduction in market share

PROFILE

Woman's Hospital Foundation is a 184 adult licensed bed facility with an 78 bed NICU that specializes in obstetric, gynecological, breast, newborn and neonatal services for women and infants in Baton Rouge and the surrounding areas. WHF is the only independent, not-for-profit women's hospital in the country and the largest delivery service in Louisiana. The hospital's Level III Surgical Neonatal Intensive Care Unit is also the largest NICU in the state.
