

A Brave Battle

Adding a new baby to the family should be one of life's most exciting times. For Mary Claire Petit, expecting her third child meant facing one of the toughest battles. Diagnosed with triple-negative breast cancer at 30 weeks pregnant, she faced a rare and deeply frightening reality that affects about one in 3,000 expectant moms.

"Here I was, a pregnant cancer patient, yet I knew I was at the center of every conversation and decision they made."

Woman's doctors and nurses guided Mary Claire every step of the way. Her chemotherapy treatments began at 35 weeks and just two weeks later, she gave birth to a healthy baby girl, Charlie.

Together, we give mothers like Mary Claire — and babies like Charlie — a brighter, stronger future.

Today, Mary Claire has beaten cancer, and the Petit family of five is embracing life. She has partnered with the Foundation for Woman's to raise awareness and support for other patients walking a similar journey.

Born weighing just **1 pound, 7.5 ounces**, Baby Brooks entered the world far too soon, with overwhelming odds stacked against him. From his very first breath, Brooks became a fighter.

For seven months, he called the Woman's NICU home. Every day brought new challenges — and new milestones. Through setbacks and small victories, his care team and family held fast to hope, celebrating each precious ounce gained and every step forward.

When Brooks finally went home, his journey became a testament to the power of expert care, compassion, and the love of family.

"We are so grateful for everything that the Woman's NICU has done for our baby," said Brooks' parents. "There is never any doubt you are loved here."

Today, Brooks is thriving — a living reminder of why we do what we do. His story embodies the very heart of our mission: to improve the health of women and infants every single day. When Christina Hall began experiencing concerning symptoms, she trusted her instincts and made an appointment with her gynecologist. That decision led to a diagnosis of uterine cancer and a referral to Dr. Anthony Evans at Woman's. From their very first meeting, Christina felt reassured by his expertise and confident she was in good hands.

In January 2025, Christina underwent a successful hysterectomy. However, routine testing afterward revealed devastating news: she also had clear cell ovarian cancer. Although overwhelmed by this second diagnosis, Christina knew she was in the right place, surrounded by a care team working closely together to provide seamless and attentive treatment.

From the moment she entered the hospital, Christina felt surrounded by kindness. Staff members knew her by name, greeted her warmly, and made a frightening experience more bearable. Determined to give back, Christina brought humor and joy to the chemotherapy unit, sharing jokes, stickers, and smiles to lift the spirits of fellow patients.

Support poured in from her family, school, and community, especially her Pre-K students, who proudly spread awareness on World Ovarian Cancer Day. Christina's story is a powerful example of what compassionate care and community support can achieve.

EXPANDING ACCESS, ELEVATING CARE

Maternal-Fetal Medicine Telehealth Transforms Maternal Care Across Louisiana

Every mother deserves access to expert care — no matter where she lives. Thanks to donor support, Woman's Maternal-Fetal Medicine (MFM) Telehealth Project is bridging the gap for women with high-risk pregnancies across Louisiana.


With Foundation funding, Woman's developed a state-of-the-art telemedicine program that allows MFM specialists in Baton Rouge to consult in real time with patients and providers in communities like Lake Charles and Monroe. Five MFM physicians are now equipped with advanced desktop systems that enable them to view live ultrasounds, review patient data, and collaborate remotely — all from a new, dedicated telemedicine hub inside the MFM clinic.

The results are already transforming care. The first telehealth partnership launched successfully at Lake Charles Memorial Hospital, with additional sites now live at Christus Ochsner Lake Area Hospital and St. Francis Medical Center in Monroe. In 2025, the program delivered more than 150 remote consultations, reducing travel time, costs, and stress for both patients and providers.

"The Woman's Maternal-Fetal Medicine team is committed to improving access, efficiency, and equity for pregnant women across Louisiana. We recognize the gaps in care and maternal health deserts in our state. By expanding our telemedicine program and leveraging advanced technology, we can now provide real-time ultrasounds and consultations remotely – delivering state-of-the-art care without delays or the burden of travel."
